Employment Requirement Document

The Plumbing Apprenticeship School is designed as a work/study program and is in compliance with the Pennsylvania Department of Labor & Industry which requires that an approved apprenticeship must include a minimum of 576 classroom hours and 8000 hours of On The Job Training.

I understand that I may attend the first year of this plumbing apprenticeship program without being employed full time by a Master Plumber as a Provisional Student. I will be actively seeking full time employment with a Master Plumber while I am attending classes in the first year.

I understand that if I gain full time employment with a Master Plumber before December 15th of my first year of class and continue to be employed full time by a Master Plumber throughout the rest of the Apprenticeship Program I will be eligible to take the Journeyman's Exam at the end of my 4th year.

If I am not employed full time by a Master Plumber by the end of my 1st year of class I understand that I **will not** be eligible to take the Journeyman's exam until I have fulfilled my On The Job Training Hours. I will be able to graduate with my class but cannot take the exam.

I also understand that if I am not employed full time by a Master Plumber before the first day of 2nd year, I will not be permitted to advance to the 2nd year.
